Smartphones have made it easy for people to stay connected at all times. Using one is pretty safe __36__ it's not done while driving. __37__, they put not only their lives but also those around them in danger.

Texting while driving IS a big problem in the United States. According to the National Safety Council, about 660,000 drivers a day use their phones to check their calls, e-mails, messages, and more while driving. This leads to __38__ each year, and one out of every four of them had been caused by texting while driving. In 2015, 391,000 people had been hurt in car crashes that involved someone texting while driving. The same year, 3,477 people __39__ their lives to it.

Sadly, teenagers are four times more likely to get into these kinds of car crashes than adults. Even though almost all of them know texting while driving is dangerous, __40__. Also, around 40% of them have been in cars where the driver was texting while driving. It's no surprise that 11 teenagers die every day because of this deadly problem.

One day, while his trainer is looking after another dog, he notices that Quill is excellent at waiting, which is an important trait for a guide dog. Later, Quill moves in to live with Mitsuru Watanabe's family and works with Watanabe for two years. With Quill's help, Mitsuru Watanabe is able to go to places faster and more safely. Then one day, Watanabe has to stay in hospital because of his poor health. Quill goes back to the training center. Years later, Quill is reunited with the couple who work as "puppy walkers." Quill lives a happy and peaceful life for a year with them. But one day, while playing at the backyard, he falls off a step and breaks several bones. Looking over a dying Quill during the night, the couple thanks him. Quill passes away at the age of 12 years.

Blood is the river of life that flows through our bodies. With every beat of the heart, blood sends oxygen to every cell in the body. For centuries, doctors wondered if it is possible to take someone's blood and put it into a patient. In 1818, Dr. James Blundell's study found how to make that possible. His findings allowed doctors to save many people's lives. As long as the right blood type is used, it is safe. O-type blood can be given to anyone in need. However, for the other blood types—A, B, or AB, doctors should be very careful when using them. A mistake with blood types could make people die.
